WELCOME to our Elgin Elementary Monday Folder program for 2017-18. Your child will be bringing home his/her Monday Folder which contains these notes from the principal, the teacher comment page, graded work, student information & permission forms, and informational fliers. Please take out and keep everything except the teacher comment page or any forms that need to be signed & returned. Sign that you received your Monday Folder, include this week's or month's Cafeteria money, and return the folder to school on Tuesdays with your child. This is our important weekly contact with the home. Soon the cafeteria will be sending home statements of charges your child has accrued. Please do not get behind on Cafeteria payments.

- During the first days of school, we learned and practiced procedures that will help us be a SUCCESS and did team building activities to develop a classroom family. We encourage students to make good behavior choices that will ensure a safe school environment conducive to learning. Important procedures include:
 - a. When arriving at school, students have two choices of where to go – the cafeteria for breakfast, 1st Grade will sit down outside their classroom. Kindergarten will go to the library. Students must be in the cafeteria prior to 8:10 to get a breakfast.
 - b. To keep the students safe, once in their building, students are not allowed to leave.
 - c. When school is dismissed how does your student get home? Bus riders have been taught their walking routes from their building to the buses which are parked in the same place every day. Students being picked up by their siblings or parents should know where that pick up place is on campus and be there waiting. The Elementary School is dismissed at 3:20 every day and that is 5 minutes before middle school and high school students are. If your child misses his school bus or daycare bus, it is because they did not follow procedures and go straight there after school.
